The Wheat and The Tares

We are in a season of discernment, a time when the Lord is separating wheat from tares. In the fields, wheat and tares often look very similar at first, but as the wheat matures, it bows under its own weight, while the tares remain upright. Farmers wait until the harvest to separate them carefully, so they do not uproot the wheat too early. Jesus shares this teaching in **Matthew 13:24-30**.

This season is an invitation to pause and reflect on our own hearts. The bowed wheat reminds us of humility and surrender to God, and the upright tares can be a gentle reminder to check areas of our lives where we may need to lean more fully on Him. Just as wheat shows its true nature over time, our character and faith are gradually revealed. Paul encourages us in **2 Corinthians 13:5** to examine ourselves and **Galatians 6:7-8** reminds us that we reap what we sow, so the posture of our hearts matters.

This is a time to reflect with kindness toward ourselves and others, to grow in humility, and to bear fruit that honours God in every season.
